

Open Letter 21. January 2020

Prime Minister of the United Kingdom of Great Britain Boris Johnson

Your Excellency,

As you may know, the prerequisite for good, neighborly relations between our states is mutual respect for the foundations of peace and friendship, as well as respect for the territorial integrity of the other state. Further, the historical difficult situation of the one, may not be the target of an abuse by the other.

It is with regret that your country has received no positive testimony from the Iranian people over the last few centuries.

Here are some examples of your country's hostile behavior towards Iran:

- The separation from Afghanistan (formerly Aryana) from Iran in 1857
- The secession from Pakistan (formerly Belutschistan) in 1871
- The separation from Bahrain in 1970
- The occupation of Iran from 1941-1946 and the destruction of the laboriously built infrastructure
- The establishment of Howze-Elmiyeh Islamic Schools in Najafi and Kerbela that destroyed Iran to your advantage.
- A genocide in the form of famine (1917-1919) in which 50% of Iranians died in agony
- Shameful oil contracts with Iran
- BBC support for Khomeini and assistance in establishing an Islamic regime in Iran
- Over \$ 400 billion of plundered funds are benevolently managed in UK banks and the Commonwealth.

Iranians' skepticism and rejection of Russian politics are the result.

The ratification of the Caspian sea agreement by the Islamic Parliament in Iran, is only by pressure and intimidation or blackmail of the parliamentary deputies by the rulers in Iran.

A letter of protest from the INS on September 18, 2019 followed and serves as a document and information for your government, as well as the governments of the

neighboring countries and European governments, which benefit from this agreement.

You and many other centers of global diplomacy are aware of the full extent of the tyranny against the Iranian people.

Excellency, we are all witnesses to the daily decline of the regime in Iran. In order to restore the loss of confidence caused by your government, we invite you and all participating states to refrain from further support from the regime in Iran.

This is in the sense of future, peaceful and respectful cooperation between our nations and corresponds to the will of the peaceful Iranian people.
