



**Open Letter
21. January 2020**

**President of Russian federation,
Wladimir Wladimirowitsch Putin President**

Your Excellency,

As you may know, the prerequisite for good, neighborly relations between our states is mutual respect for the foundations of peace and friendship, as well as respect for the territorial integrity of the other state. Further, the historical difficult situation of the one, may not be the target of an abuse by the other.

It is with regret that your country has received no positive testimony from the Iranian people over the last few centuries.

Here are some examples of your country's hostile behavior towards Iran:

- **The occupation and secession of the Caucasus from Iran in 1813 and**
- **The Turkmenistan in 1828**
- **The bombardment of the Parliament with guns of the Cossacks on 23 June**
- **The Occupation of the Northern Territories of Iran 1912**
- **The occupation of Iran 1941-1946**
- **The support of the separatists in Kurdistan and Azerbaijan 1945**
- **As a final example, mention should be made of the forthcoming agreement on the legal status of the Caspian Sea.**

Iranians' skepticism and rejection of Russian politics are the result.

The ratification of the Caspiansea agreement by the Islamic Parliament in Iran, is only by pressure and intimidation or blackmail of the parliamentary deputies by the rulers in Iran.

A letter of protest from the INS on September 18, 2019 followed and serves as a document and information for your government, as well as the governments of the neighboring countries and European governments, which benefit from this agreement.

You and many other centers of global diplomacy are aware of the full extent of the tyranny against the Iranian people.

In November 2019, we witnessed the crackdown on protests in Iran, and as a result, the regime received your government's full support for the regime's brutal crackdown on its own people.
